Notes: 3mm aluminium composite panel with printed and laminated graphics applied.

Tenant names to be printed decals for updating in future.

Mounted on existing 114mm posts.

Fonts: Rockwell


Computer screens and desktop printers may not give a true representation of finished colours.

This is our Signs Now artwork approval stage. As shown, the measurements have been added to the propsed design, alongside a description of the signage, colour references and fonts used.



## ARTWORK APPROVAL design | service | solutions |



As seen the customer has approved the artwork which the Signs Now designs team sent. Only at this point will the signs get passed into production and an installation date will be arranged directly with the customer once the signs are almost complete!

After the sign artwork has been approved, the next stage at Signs Now involves quality control checks...



Before starting the manufacturing of the signage, a final colour check is compared to the artwork approval form. For most jobs, it is essential the CMYK colour matches as this guides the print on the signs.



A final check of the logo layout is made.





Once the colours and logo have been confirmed, the Signs Now team complete a in-line inspection. This means that signs are checked in-between the different machinery to ensure the signage quality remains high.



A final inspection is made before packaging the signage! Ready to go to you ...



#### Choose the right logo and graphics:

Ensure that your signs are not too cluttered therefore choosing the most suitable logos to incorporate and graphics are essential.

#### **Choose the right colours:**

It is vital there is a good contrast with the chosen colours on your sign. For example, at Sign Now we would not recommend yellow on red or green on blue as this may be difficult to read.



#### **Choose the right layout:**

To create an aesthetically pleasing sign, having an appropriate layout is necessary. For example, appropriate spacing between images and text (symmetry) is important for the final look.

#### Choosing the right signage system:

When it comes to design, making sure the most suitable sign type is chosen is extremely important. This is because it will influence how much colour and text there should be.
